



(Numbers in millions USD)





### Summary of the Paraguayan International Trade

#### Exports (FOB)

- January-September 2023: USD 8.9 billion
- January-September 2022: USD 7.7 billion
- Growth in value: USD 1.2 billion
- Growth in percentage: 15.8%

#### Countries or trade blocs that mostly impacted on exports growth

- MERCOSUR (USD 1.5 billion)
- Countries associated to Mercosur (USD 80 million)

#### Products which mostly impacted on exports outcome

- Soy (USD 1.6 billion)
- Rice (USD 107 million)

#### Imports (CIF)

- January-September 2023: USD 11.7 billion
- January-September 2022: USD 11.8 billion
- Growth in value: USD -107 million
- Growth in percentage: -0.9%

- Russia (USD -160 million)
- ASEAN (USD -118 million)

#### Products which mostly impacted on imports outcome

- Petrol oil (USD -253 million)
- Aluminium sheets (USD -70 million)
