

Top trading partners of Paraguay


January-August 2023



Exports (FOB)

- January-August 2023: USD 7.8 billion
- January-August 2022: USD 6.8 billion
- Growth in value: USD 1.1 billion
- Growth in percentage: 16.9%

Countries or trade blocs that mostly impacted on exports growth

- MERCOSUR (USD 1.3 billion)
- Countries associated to Mercosur (USD 105 million)

Products which mostly impacted on exports outcome

- Soy (USD 1.4 billion)
- Rice (USD 101 million)

Imports (CIF)

- January-August 2023: USD 10.2 billion
- January-August 2022: USD 10.4 billion
- Growth in value: USD -126 million

- ASEAN (USD -98 million)
