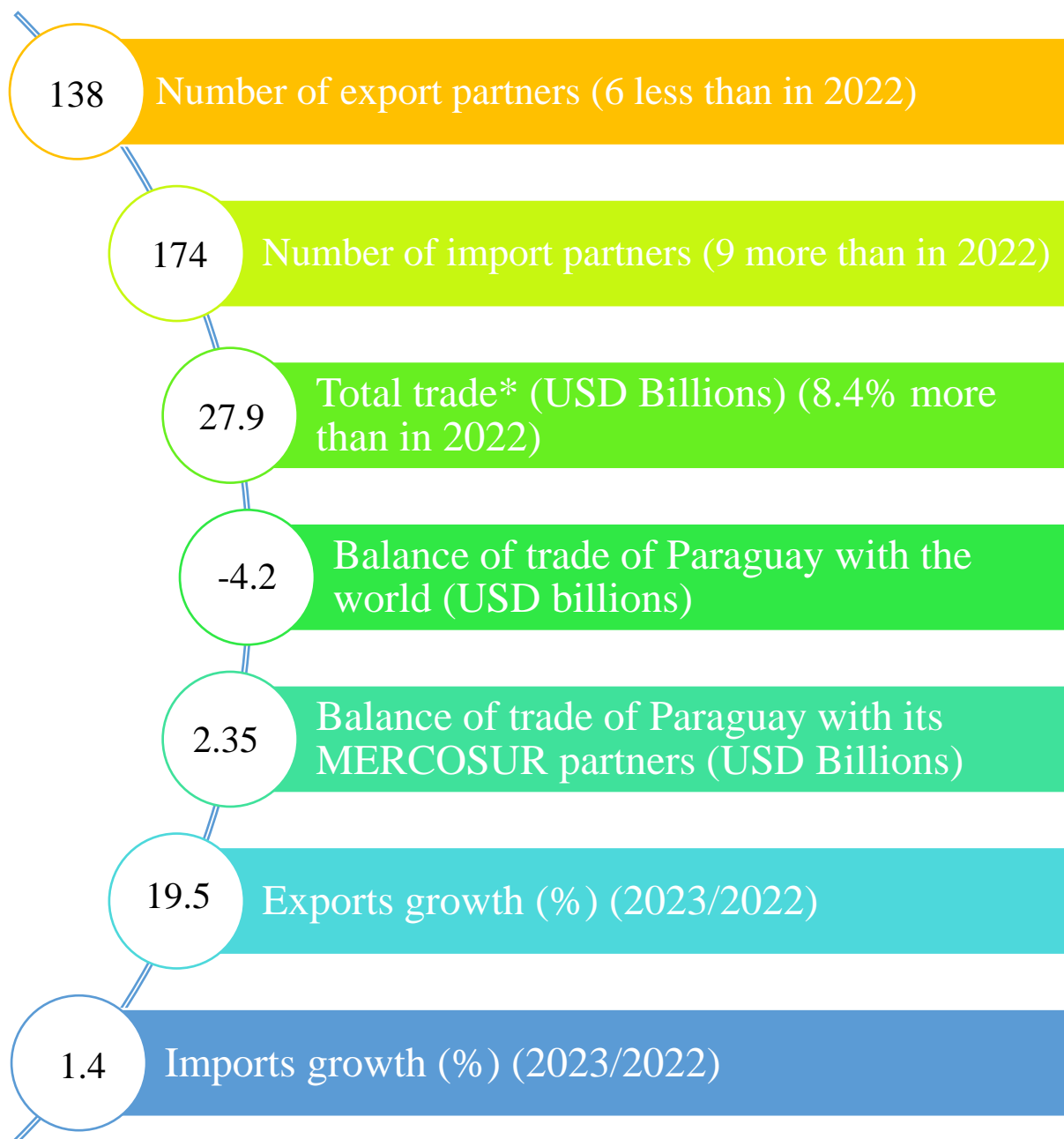

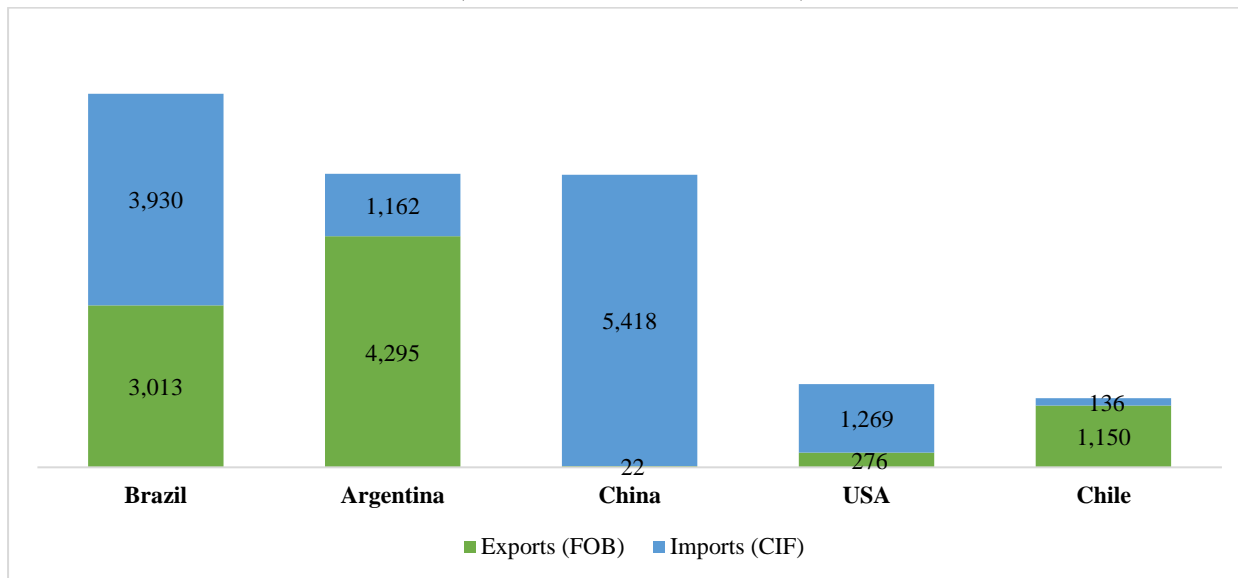

(Numbers in millions USD)

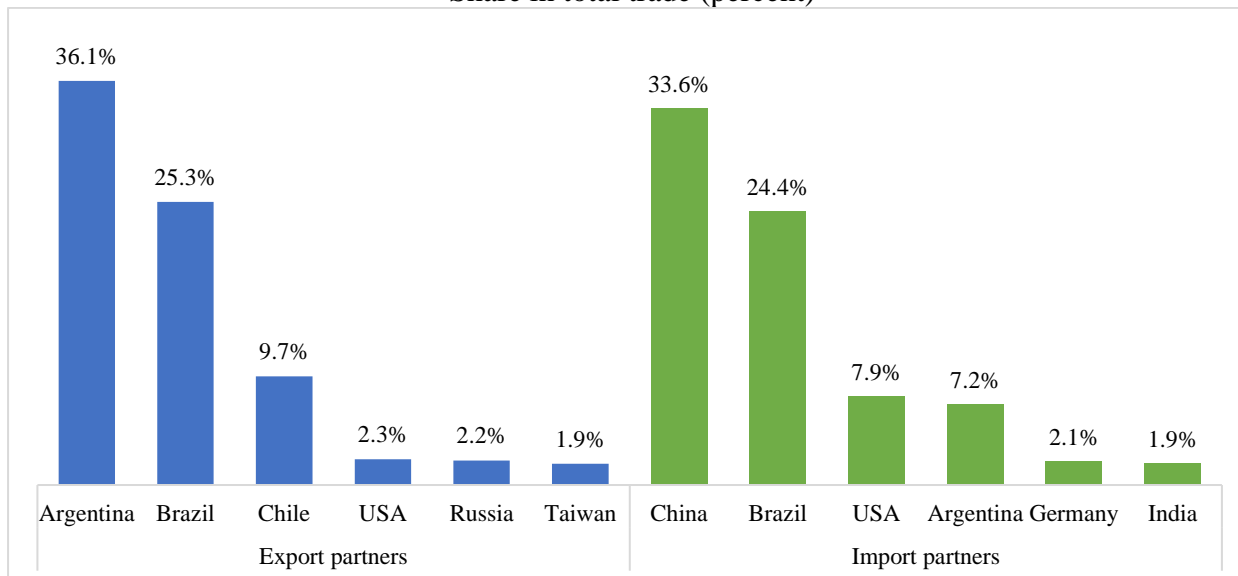

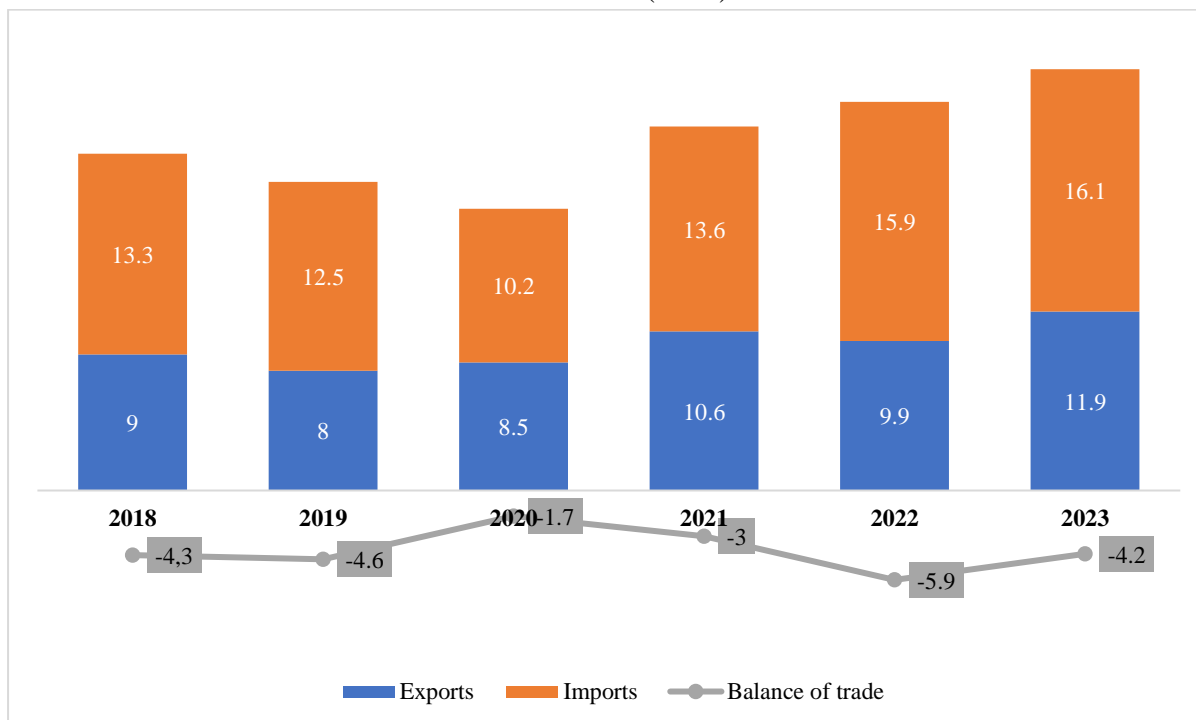

Summary of the Paraguayan International Trade

Exports (FOB)

- January-December 2023: USD 11.8 billion
- January-December 2022: USD 9.9 billion
- Growth in value: USD 1.9 billion
- Growth in percentage: 19.5%

Countries or trade blocs that mostly impacted on exports growth

- MERCOSUR (USD 1.8 billion)
- Countries associated to Mercosur (USD 97 million)

Products which mostly impacted on exports outcome

- Soy (USD 2.2 billion)
- Soy flour (USD 299 million)

Imports (CIF)

- January-December 2023: USD 16.1 billion
- January-December 2022: USD 15.8 billion
- Growth in value: USD 225 million
- Growth in percentage: 1.4%

- EU-27 (USD 56 million)

Products which mostly impacted on imports outcome

- Telephone devices (USD 876 million)
- Machinery (USD 54 million)
