

Top trading partners of Paraguay


January-November 2023



Exports (FOB)

- January-November 2023: USD 11 billion
- January-November 2022: USD 9.2 billion
- Growth in value: USD 1.8 billion
- Growth in percentage: 19.1%

Countries or trade blocs that mostly impacted on exports growth

- MERCOSUR (USD 1.6 billion)
- Countries associated to Mercosur (USD 149 million)

Products which mostly impacted on exports outcome

- Soy (USD 2 billion)
- Soy flour (USD 219 million)
