



Exports (FOB)

- January-October 2023: USD 10 billion
- January-October 2022: USD 8.4 billion
- Growth in value: USD 1.5 billion
- Growth in percentage: 18.1%

Countries or trade blocs that mostly impacted on exports growth

- MERCOSUR (USD 1.6 billion)
- Countries associated to Mercosur (USD 127 million)

Products which mostly impacted on exports outcome

- Soy (USD 1.8 billion)
- Rice (USD 169 million)
